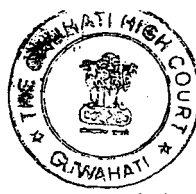

1. Online applications are invited from the persons having not more than 35 (thirty five) years age in case of General candidates and 38 (thirty eight) years of age in case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates as on 31-05-2013 for appointment to 21 (twenty one) actual and anticipated vacant posts (Subject to variation on both sides) in **Grade-III of the Assam Judicial Service** in the Pay Scale of Rs.27700-770-33090-920-40450-1080-44770/- per month + other allowances as admissible under the Rules, so as to reach the undersigned on or before 31-05-2013 (till 5.00 P.M.)
2. **Out of posts advertised 19 are actual and 2 are anticipated vacancies till 31st December 2013. However, at the time of declaring final merit list, the actual vacancy position may vary on either side. Mere selection would not *per se* entitle a candidate to claim appointment.**
3. A candidate must be a citizen of India as defined in Articles 5 & 6 of the Constitution of India. The candidate must be a Graduate in Law from any recognized University.
4. The candidates shall have to appear in a Preliminary Examination (Screening test) of 100 marks containing objective questions with multiple choice, out of which 90 marks will cover General Knowledge, Aptitude, English, Constitution of India, Code of Civil Procedure, Code of Criminal Procedure, Transfer of Property Act, Indian Contract Act, Indian Penal Code, Indian Evidence Act, Law of Torts and remaining 10 marks will test the proficiency in Official Language(s) of the State of Assam. Those candidates who secure 60% or more marks shall be eligible for appearing in the Main Written Examination. For the Main Written Examination, 10 candidates will be called against 1 vacancy (1:10) subject to securing marks in Preliminary examination as mentioned above. Successful candidates in the Main Written Examination shall be called for Interview/Viva-voce. Candidates shall have to bear their own expenses for appearing in the written examination/ Viva Voce.
5. All candidates who obtain 60 (sixty) percent or more aggregate marks in the Main Written Examination subject to securing 45 percent marks in the individual papers I, II & III and minimum 35% marks in the official language paper shall be eligible for Viva-Voce Examination. Provided that Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe candidates who obtain 50 (fifty) percent or more aggregate marks subject to obtaining 40 percent marks in the individual paper I, II & III and minimum 35% marks in the language paper shall be eligible for Viva-Voce Examination. Candidates will be called for the Viva-voce/ interview in the ratio of 1:3. In the Viva-Voce, out of 50 marks the candidates will have to secure minimum 60% marks. The final selection shall be made subject to overall suitability.
6. On selection, the candidates shall have to undergo Pre-Appointment Training as per Rules.
7. Candidates selected to undergo the training course will have to qualify in an examination to be conducted by the concerned Institute/School/Academy, on completion of the course.
8. Reservation for candidates belonging to reserved categories will be made as per existing Rules governing the recruitment. Further, 30% reservation of vacancies for the woman, as per "The Assam Woman (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 2005" and High Court Notification No. HC. VII- 04/2009/980/A, dated 02.02.2009 and other reservations prescribed by law and applicable to the service as decided by the High Court will be made.


